Campaign overview

'We've got campaigns to ensure people don't go out in the sun, expose themselves to the sun for fear that they might get melanoma or skin cancer. This is no different. We must inform the community about where asbestos is located, what it looks like, what the dangers are.'

Asbestos is still present in millions of homes, as well as public and commercial buildings across Australia. In homes built before 1990, asbestos can still be found anywhere. This affects 1 in 3 homes nationwide.

This campaign asks the NSW community to Be Asbestos Ready. The campaign challenges complacency by reminding home renovators and tradespeople that the danger of asbestos is far from over.

The aim of the campaign is to raise awareness amongst the public and key trades about the health risks associated with exposure to asbestos fibres, where asbestos products can be found and prompt behavioural change – to plan for the possibility of asbestos and to contact a licensed asbestos professional.

Purpose of this stakeholder campaign pack

Following the launch of the NSW asbestos awareness campaign in April 2022, the purpose of this stakeholder pack is to provide consistent awareness messages for the NSW community during National Asbestos Awareness Week (20-26 November 2023) and beyond. We encourage stakeholders to continue to use these assets until 30 June 2024.

The stakeholder pack includes:

- A collection of assets for stakeholders to distribute through their communication and marketing channels.
 - » All files are supplied as final campaign assets, unless otherwise indicated (JPEGs, MP4s and Word docs).





If your home was built before 1990, it could contain asbestos. Asbestos can be found throughout the home, in walls, bathrooms, ceilings, floors, laundries, kitchens,roofs, fences and garages. Asbestos is dangerous when damaged, disturbed or deteriorating so you shouldn't remove it yourself. Four times more people die from asbestos related diseases annually than on our roads. If you're looking to renovate, planning ahead will help avoid delays and cost blow outs.

Be Asbestos Ready

Before you begin a renovation, please follow these three simple steps.

- Think ahead: Remember that asbestos was used in over 3000 building products and can be found throughout the home.
- 2. Plan ahead: Exposure to asbestos fibres can cause cancer. Fibres from disturbed, damaged or deteriorating asbestos are easily inhaled and can be a health risk. There's no fast or easy way to remove it, so plan ahead to avoid delays and cost blow outs.
- **3. Get a professional:** Please don't risk your health, or anyone else's health. If you're renovating, start by contacting a licensed asbestos professional if you aren't trained to locate, manage or remove it.

If you're renovating a home built before 1990, it may contain asbestos. Asbestos is dangerous when damaged, disturbed or deteriorating so you shouldn't remove it yourself. Four times more people die from asbestos related diseases annually than on our roads. If you're working on a property discuss with your client a plan to protect your health, avoid delays and cost blow outs, if asbestos is found.

Be Asbestos Ready

Before you begin a renovation, please follow these three simple steps.

- Think ahead: Australia has one of the highest rates of asbestos-related diseases in the world, including cancer. So, if the home you are working on was built before 1990, remember that asbestos might be found. It was used in over 3000 building products.
- 2. Plan ahead: Asbestos is dangerous when disturbed, so you shouldn't remove asbestos yourself. Making a contingency plan in case asbestos is found will avoid delays and cost blow outs.
- **3. Get a licensed asbestos professional:** They will provide advice on how to protect everyone's health and help you proceed safely.
